Great British Insulation Scheme

- The Great British Insulation Scheme is a government initiative aimed at improving the energy efficiency of homes across the UK. It focuses on providing insulation measures to households, particularly those in lower council tax bands and with lower energy performance ratings.
- The scheme's goal is to reduce energy consumption, lower utility bills, and contribute to the UK's carbon reduction targets.

SUGGESTIONS & TIPS



- Ensure your home has an Energy Performance Certificate (EPC) rating of D to G.
- Verify that your property falls within council tax bands A to D in England.
- Check if you qualify for installations such as cavity wall insulation and loft insulation.
- Contact approved installer partners to assess your home's eligibility and arrange installations.
- For residents in Birmingham, contact the trusted installer partners appointed by the City Council on its website.

Home Upgrade Grant Phase (HUG2)

- The Home Upgrade Grant Phase 2 (HUG2) is a government-funded scheme targeting properties not connected to the gas grid.
- It aims to deliver energy-saving measures to improve the energy efficiency of these homes, thereby reducing energy bills and carbon emissions.

Home Upgrade Grant Phase (HUG2) SUGGESTIONS & TIPS



Eligibility Criteria:

- Your property must be off the gas grid.
- Check if your local authority is participating in the HUG2 scheme.

Potential Improvements:

- Insulation upgrades (e.g., wall, loft, or floor insulation).
- Installation of low-carbon heating systems.

How to Apply:

- Contact your local council to inquire about participation and application procedures.

Boiler Upgrade Scheme

- The Boiler Upgrade Scheme is designed to encourage property owners to install low-carbon heating systems, such as heat pumps and biomass boilers, as a replacement for traditional fossil fuel boilers.
- The scheme offers financial support to offset the installation costs, of adopting of renewable heating technologies.

Boiler Upgrade Scheme SUGGESTIONS & TIPS



Eligibility Requirements:

- Ownership of a property in England or Wales.
- The existing heating system should be a fossil fuel boiler (e.g., gas, oil, or electric).

Available Grants:

- Up to **£5,000** for air source heat pumps.
- Up to **£6,000** for ground source heat pumps.
- Up to **£5,000** for biomass boilers.

Application Process:

- Engage a certified installer who will apply for the grant on your behalf.

Energy Company Obligation 4 (ECO4)

- The Energy Company Obligation 4 (ECO4) is a government energy efficiency scheme for Great Britain, focusing on low-income, fuel-poor, and vulnerable households.
- It requires larger energy suppliers to fund the installation of energy efficiency measures in eligible homes to help reduce carbon emissions and tackle fuel poverty.

Energy Company Obligation 4 (ECO4) SUGGESTIONS & TIPS



Eligibility Criteria:

- Households receiving certain means-tested benefits.
- Properties with an EPC rating of D, E, F, or G.

Available Measures:

- Insulation (e.g., cavity wall, loft, or solid wall insulation).
- Heating system upgrades & renewable energy installations.

How to Apply:

- Contact your energy supplier to inquire about available support under ECO4.
- Alternatively, reach out to local authorities or approved installers participating in the scheme.
